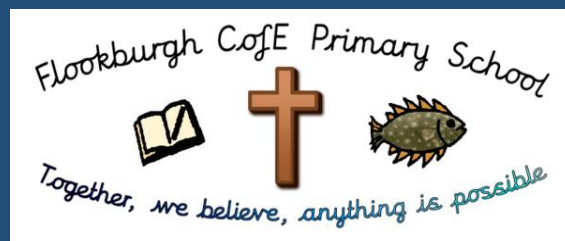

CLASS OF THE WEEK CLASS 1: Over the last three weeks, Class 1 have been on a voyage of discovery through the solar system! We've learnt all about the eight planets, researching facts and writing down which one is our favourite and why, and have each made a polystyrene planet to add to our class planetarium. To help us to understand how the planets move through space, we made planet and Sun headbands so that we could place ourselves in the correct order and follow our circular orbits; please check out our video on Facebook if you haven't already! To ignite our interest in engineering, we've had quite a few rocket design activities going on. Reception all made spectacular spacecraft models of their own for homework, and we evaluated each other's designs before voting for our favourite. In school, we've also enjoyed making tall rockets out of various blocks and mobilo. To examine space more closely, we've each made an extendable telescope; we'll be stargazing in no time!



Over the last week, our space theme has taken on a new twist: the aliens are here, and they're after our underpants! We've had fun painting aliens and making them their own pants so that they don't steal ours! There now also seems to be a flotilla of UFOs buzzing around inside Class 1... It's all a bit bonkers, but we wouldn't have it any other way!

MESSY CHURCH: Classes 3 and 4 had a fantastic afternoon exploring aspects of the Holy Spirit as part of our work on understanding the Trinity. The children took part in practical activities to explore this concept: Creating Fire; Watching fire cause change; the power of the wind, using a parachute and understanding the different 'tongue'. We all went home with windmills which we had made and enjoyed eating the pop-corn we made on the fire-pit.
